IN CRIMINAL BAIL APPLICATION NO.482/2026
(CNR No.MHRG17000962026)

By way of present application, applicant Saiyad Rijban Esmail is claiming ad-interim anticipatory bail in Crime No. 204/2026, registered with Nhava Sheva police Station for the offences punishable under section 69 of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023

2. The learned advocate Shri Rahul Varde for applicant vehemently argued that, the applicant is innocent. He has been falsely implicated in the crime in question. He further argued that, in such circumstances, if applicant is arrested, the very purpose of filing present anticipatory bail application will be frustrated and irreparable loss will be caused to the applicant. Hence, Shri Varde prayed that, till the final disposal of main anticipatory bail application, ad-interim anticipatory bail may kindly be granted to the applicant.

3. I have carefully heard the submissions advanced by learned advocate Shri Varde for applicant. I have also perused the application below Exh.4 for ad-interim anticipatory bail. The opponent State yet to appear and file its respective say. If applicant is arrested in connection with crime in question, the very purpose of filing present application will be frustrated. In such circumstances, it will be necessary to protect the personal liberty of applicant till the appearance of opponent state. Hence,

without going into the merits of main application of an anticipatory bail, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application for ad-interim bail is allowed.
2. In the event of arrest of applicant Saiyad Rijban Esmail in Crime No.107/2025, registered with Taloja police station for the offences punishable under section 69 of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, he shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail, on his executing PR. bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/-, with one surety in the like amount.
3. The applicant is hereby directed not to interfere with the investigation of the crime in question and shall make himself available for interrogation as and when directed by concerned Investigating Officer and to co-operate with the investigation.
4. The applicant shall not pressurize the prosecution witnesses and tamper with the prosecution evidence.
5. The applicant shall not leave the jurisdiction of this Court without prior permission of the Court.
6. Issue notice to Ld.Public Prosecutor to show cause as to why ad-interim order should not be made absolute R/o 04/06/2026.
7. The order of ad-interim anticipatory bail shall remain in force till 04/06/2026.
8. Inform the concerned police station.
