**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 5 IN SESSIONS CASE NO.73/2025**  
**(DATED: 24/02/2026)**

1] Applicant Pritam Arun Mhatre has filed present application for relaxation of condition No. 2(v) which is imposed upon him while granting bail to him in Cri. Bail Application No. 895/2024. The said condition is as follows -

condition No. 2(v) “the applicant/accused shall not enter the village Nhave gaon, Tal. Panvel, Dist. Raigad till disposal of the case or further order of this Court whichever is earlier.”

2] It is submitted by Ld.Adv. Smt. Mangal Gore that as per order of Sessions Court applicant/accused never entered the village Nhave gaon, Tal. Panvel, Dist. Raigad. Likewise, he never contacted to informant and breached any condition of the bail order. Smt. Mangal Gore further submitted that apart from his family house at Village Nhave, the applicant/accused has no other residence. Therefore, it has become very difficult for him to stay away from his house. Smt. Mangal Gore further submitted that the investigation is completed and charge-sheet has been filed in the Court. In such circumstance no purpose will be served if the condition No. 2(v) of the bail order is continued. The applicant/accused is ready to abide by the terms and conditions which may be imposed by the court. Hence, Adv. Gore prayed that the condition No. 2(v) of the order passed in Cri. Bail

Appln. No. 895/2024 be relaxed.

3] Per contra, Ld APP Shri. R.E. Yerunkar argued that the offence is serious. If the condition No. 2(v) of the bail order is relaxed and applicant is allowed to enter the village Nhave, definitely he will bring pressure on material witness. Hence, it is prayed by Shri. Yerunkar that the application be rejected.

4] I have given thoughtful consideration to the submissions advanced by both the Ld. Advocates. I have also gone through the material placed on record. The investigation with regard to crime in question is complete and charge-sheet has been filed. It is not the case of prosecution that the present applicant has pressurized witnesses and tempered with the evidence. Considering the reason assigned in the application, it appears to be genuine. In view of aforesaid factual aspects, in my view, the condition No. 2(v) of the bail order deserves to be relaxed. Hence, I pass the following order -

**ORDER**

1.	Application is allowed.
2.	The condition No. 2(v) i.e. "the applicant/accused shall not enter the village Nhave gaon, Tal. Panvel, Dist. Raigad till disposal of the case or further order of this Court whichever is earlier." imposed upon applicant in Cri. Bail Appln. No 895/2024 is hereby relaxed.
3.	Inform the concerned police station.
