1. This is an application filed by accused **Jayesh Ramesh Bhosale** under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (in short "BNSS") for bail.
2. I.O. has filed say at Exh.5 and strongly opposed the bail application.
3. The accused has been charge sheeted in respect of Neral Police Station C.R. No.57/2026 for the offences punishable

under Section 64(2)(i) of the BNS and under Section 4 & 6 of the POCSO Act.

4. Perused application, say thereon and documents produced on the record. Heard both sides.
5. Ld. Advocate for accused submitted that, the accused is falsely implicated in the present crime. The accused is in custody since 27/04/2026. The investigation is completed. The victim has no complaint against the accused. False allegations are made against the accused. The accused is ready to abide any condition to be imposed by the Court.
6. Ld. Spl. P. P. Smt. Madhuri Thalkar submitted that accused had committed aggravated penetrative sexual assault on the victim. Despite knowing that the victim is minor, the accused performed marriage with victim. He committed rape repeatedly on the victim. Hence, prosecution prayed to reject the application.
7. Perused charge-sheet and material placed on record. It appears that accused and victim got acquainted with each other before 2 years of FIR. They developed love relationship. Thereafter they decided to marry each other. In May 2025 the accused and victim got married. However their marriage was not registered anywhere. Out of the said relation she became pregnant and gave birth to female child on 01/03/2026 at Central Hospital, Ulhasnagar. It is alleged that though accused was knowing that victim was minor, he performed marriage with her. From May 2025 to September 2025 the accused had sexual intercourse with

victim. Therefore, informant/victim lodged report with Neral Police Station.

8. Prima facie it appears that, at the time of incident victim was 16 years old. There was love relation between the accused and victim. They married with each other. Out of the said wedlock, victim begotten female child. The victim was present at the time of hearing of the application alongwith her grandmother. She has given no objection for grant of bail. It seems that the accused had not used force to the victim. The accused is 20 years old young boy, who is in custody since 27/04/2026. Now the investigation has been completed. Therefore, further detention of the accused would not serve the purpose of justice. As a result, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Accused **Jayesh Ramesh Bhosale** be released on furnishing P.B. and S.B. of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) with one or two surety in like amount in Neral Police Station C.R.No.57/2026 for the offences punishable under Section 64(2)(i) of the BNS and under Section 4 & 6 of the POCSO Act.
3. Accused shall not leave India without previous permission of the Trial Court.

4. Accused shall not directly and indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with facts and circumstances of case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the police and Court.
5. Accused shall furnish his permanent and temporary residential proof, valid e-mail ID and mobile number.
6. Accused shall co-operate in investigation and make himself available for investigation as and when required by the investigation officer.
7. Inform the concerned police station and jail authority, accordingly.

(Application is disposed of accordingly)
