ORDER BELOW EXH. 3

1) Accused No.1- Vijay Madhav Dhone, 2- Rohan Kumar Javane, 3- Tanmay Bhausahab Kapare, 4- Milkasing Kamalsing Rajput, 5-Mayur Vilas Pawar, 6-Sandesh Babasaheb Kale, 7- Aftaaf Lalshah Mujawar, 8- Prashik Atul Kamble, 9- Tejas Rakesh Gavit, 10-Vedant Namdev Sanap, 11-Gaurav Dattatrya Madke and 12- Omkar Jeevan Lohar moved this application for bail.

2) I.O. has filed say to this application vide Exh.5 and submitted that no objection to allow the present application on certain terms and conditions.

3) Perused application, say thereon and documents produced on the record. Notice of this bail application was issued to informant. Accordingly, informant appeared through Ld. Advocate Nitin Kadarale and filed say at Exh.9 and opposed the said bail application. Heard Ld. Addl.PP, Ld. Advocate for accused and Ld. Advocate for informant.

4) Ld. Advocate for accused submitted that during the investigation accused persons co-operated with the investigation machinery, hence they were not arrested during the investigation. Accused persons have no

antecedent. Accused persons shall be easily available to face the trial. Accused persons are ready to obey any conditions to be imposed by the Court.

5) Ld. Addl. P. P. Shri. Kadam submitted that though charge-sheet is filed, considering the nature and gravity of the offence it is not proper to release applicants on bail. If applicants are released on bail, there is possibility of the pressurizing the victim and prosecution witnesses. Hence, prosecution prayed for rejection of bail.

6) Ld. Advocate Shri. Nitin Kadarale for the informant submitted that, if the accused persons released on bail, they will pressurize the informant and witnesses and tamper the evidence. Hence, he prayed for rejection of bail.

7) Perused F.I.R and documents placed on record. It is alleged that the informant and accused were knowing each other. The accused are belonging to Scheduled Caste community. The informant was studying in Tasgavkar college of Physiotherapy, Chandai, Tal.Karjat. On 02/06/2025 at about 18.30 hours all the accused abused the informant and assaulted by wrist bracelet, baseball stick and fist and blows on the ground that informant created Instagram account by name Tasgavkar Bhim. Thereafter, again the informant was taken in hostel room by accused No.1 to 7 and abused him by caste name and also assaulted

him. He was also threatened by the accused. Therefore, informant lodged report against the accused persons.

8) It appears that, the investigating officer issued notice to the applicants under section 35(3) of the BNSS. It seems that, arrest of the applicants was not required by the police. The charge-sheet has been filed. After charge-sheet summons to applicants were issued by this court. Accordingly, the applicants/accused persons appeared and filed this bail application. Now the investigation is in all respect is completed. The custodial interrogation is not necessary. The offences are not punishable with life or death. Hence, I am inclined to grant this bail application by imposing certain conditions. Therefore, I proceed to pass following order.

:: ORDER ::

1. Application is allowed.
2. Applicant/accused **No.1** Vijay Madhav Dhone, **2-** Rohan Kumar Javane, **3-** Tanmay Bhausahab Kapare, **4-** Milkasing Kamalsing Rajput, **5-**Mayur Vilas Pawar, **6-**Sandesh Babasaheb Kale, **7-** Aftaaf Lalshah Mujawar, **8-** Prashik Atul Kamble, **9-** Tejas Rakesh Gavit, **10-**Vedant Namdev Sanap, **11-**Gaurav Dattatrya Madke and **12-** Omkar Jeevan Lohar be released on furnishing P.B. and S.B. of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) each

with one or two surety in like amount in Spl (Atrocity) Case No.184/2025 arising out of C.R. No.159/2025 registered at Karjat Police Station.

3. If the applicant/accused persons unable to furnish surety, they are at liberty to deposit cash security amount of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) each.
4. Applicant Nos.1 to 12 shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
5. Applicant Nos.1 to 12 shall not directly and indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with facts and circumstances of case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the police and Court.
6. Applicant Nos.1 to 12 shall furnish their permanent and temporary residential proof, valid e-mail ID and mobile number.
7. Applicant Nos.1 to 12 in future, shall not commit offence of similar nature.
8. Inform the concerned police station, accordingly.
