



Order Below Exh.32
(In Sessions Case No.158/2022)

1. Present application is filed by accused Jini Ebin Samuel for grant of permission for new passport. Applicant is accused in C.R. No.267/2016 registered at Khopoli Police Station, Dist. Raigad for offences punishable under section 353, 332, 336, 338, 160, 147, 148, 149, 186, 188, 504 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and u/s. 135 r/w 37(1)(3) of Maharashtra Police Act, 1949.
2. In application, Applicant has pleaded that she needs passport for her business purpose and to travel around the world. Say of Ld. A.P.P. was called upon. Say is filed overleaf the said application. Prosecution has strongly objected the application on the ground that to which country Applicant will visit and for what period is not mentioned in the application.
3. Heard Ld. Adv. for the Applicant/accused and Ld. Addl. P. P of the State of Maharashtra.
4. Applicant is residing at Khopoli. As per her, she intends to possess passport for her business purpose and to travel around the world. Applicant has filed photocopy of online appointment receipt. By this application, Applicant is seeking permission to possess passport and there is no ground for rejecting her prayer. The citizen of India has right to move anywhere he wishes and Article 19 and 21 of Constitution of



India permits traveling as fundamental right subject to certain restrictions. Considering the nature of case and offence it would be proper to grant permission to Applicant to obtain a new passport. Hence, I pass following order.

:: ORDER ::

1. Application is allowed.
2. This Court has no objection for granting new passport to accused Jini Ebin Samuel as per rules.
3. Accused shall not travel abroad without prior permission of this Court.
