ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

The applicant Ajit Tanaji Sawant moved this application seeking no objection of this court for renewal of his passport.

2. I.O. has filed say to this application at Exh.6 and thereby strongly opposed the application. The Learned Addl. PP submitted that, if permission to renewal of passport is granted, there is possibility of the absconding respondent and will not be available for trial. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

3. Ld. Advocate for applicant submitted that passport bearing No. L **6284511** of applicant is expired on 06/01/2024. Applicant has applied for renewal of Passport. However, passport authority insisted for no objection of the Court. Therefore, the applicant has filed this application along with his affidavit.

4. Neral Police Station Cr.No. 80/2020 for the offences punishable under section 500, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and section 3 (1)(r)(s)(u) of Scheduled Caste And Scheduled Tribes (Prevention Of Atrocities) Act, 1989 was registered.

5. Perused record of the case. Merely because present crime is pending against the applicant, the right of the applicant for renewal of passport cannot be denied. Thus, in order to process the documentation insisted by the passport department as such, this court has no objection for renewal of applicant's passport as per the rules. With this, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application Exh. 1 is hereby allowed.
2. This Court has no objection for renewal of passport of applicant **Ajit Tanaji Sawant** by the concerned passport authority as per rules.
3. Applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of this Court.
