(DR.SUHAS RAMKRISHNA KULKARNI -V/S. - DR.SAIRA
BALEKHAN MULLA AND 2)
(PASSED ON 10th DAY OF MAY, 2024)

1. The applicant is the husband filed petition against respondent/wife for custody of child – Soniya Suhas Kulkarni, aged 12 years. During pendency of this application, the applicant prayed for interim relief of visitation right to the child.
2. Respondent No.1 filed say vide Exh.11.
3. The applicant moved this application in person. He has not engaged any advocate. The wife has conceded for visitation right to the child during pendency of hearing of this application. The child is aged 12 years as such, her willingness was also considered. The child appeared and stated that she wish to stay with the mother, however she has no objection to visit the father.

4. With the consent of both parties and the child, access is permitted to the husband/petitioner with the child on second and fourth Saturday of the month in between 6.30 p.m to 7.30 p.m. in a ice-cream shop proximate to the area of respondent. The telephonic communication is permitted at the will and wish of the daughter. The child has her own cell number and she used to communicate with the father. Thus the access as above and communication is permitted to the petitioner. With this, I pass following order;

ORDER

1)	The petitioner/husband is accorded leave for visitation and access to the child twice in a month on second and fourth Saturday of the month during the period 6.30 p.m to 7.30 p.m. in a ice-cream shop near to the premises of respondent at the will and wish of the child.
2)	The petitioner/husband is permitted for mobile communication to the daughter either at her cell number or at the cell phone of the respondent No.1.
3)	The petitioner/husband shall receive to the child from her place of residence and drop the child at the place of residence, during above visits.

4)	The petitioner/husband shall not misuse this concession granted above during course of visit to the daughter and communication with her.
5)	The petitioner shall observe all safety and precautions of the child/daughter during his visit and shall not allow any further instance of quarrels between himself and the respondent during such visit, if respondent accompanied with the child.
6)	The petitioner shall report to this court if any such instance by the respondent took place during course of above visits and communication.
7)	The petitioner/husband shall not offer any expensive eatables, toys, gifts or any other article to the child.
8)	Parties to take note of it.
