ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO. 12 IN SPECIAL CASE NO. 262/2025
(Date : 25/03/2026)**

The applicant Sudarshan Vasant Sawant has filed present application seeking interim custody of the Suzuki access scooter.

2] It is the case of applicant that he is registered owner of Suzuki Access scooter bearing registration No.MH06/DB-2454 having its Chassis No.MB8EN11AHS8530051 and Engine No. AF261163667/NA. The police of Khalapur police Station have seized said scooter in connection with C.R.No.340/2025 registered with Khalapur police station for the offences punishable under Sections 8(c), 20(b) (ii) and 29) of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

3] It is the case of applicant that above mentioned vehicle has been seized by Khalapur Police station. Said scooter is having no concern with the crime in question. Applicant requires said vehicle for his daily use. The police have kept said scooter in the Police Station in open condition for long period. It

will prone to natural decay on account of weather conditions. He is ready to abide by the terms and conditions which may be imposed upon him by the Court. Hence, it is prayed by him that the interim custody of above numbered scooter be given to him.

4] The opponent-State has filed its say at Exh.19 and given no objection to hand over custody of seized scooter.

5] Heard learned advocate Shri.R.R.Pawar for the applicant and learned Spl PP Shri Y.S.Bhopi for the opponent State. Perused the application, say and documents available on record.

6] Shri. Pawar the learned advocate for applicant made his submissions on the line of averments made in his application whereas Shri. Bhopi, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor made his respective submissions on the line of averments made in his say.

7] The applicant has filed his affidavit in support of the application wherein it is stated by him that he is the owner of the scooter in question. He also produced on record registration certificate of the scooter in question, insurance copy which shows that the scooter in question stands in the name of present applicant. Applicant has also filed his Aadhar card.

8] It is observed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Sunderbai Ambalal Desai V/s State of Gujarat, AIR 2003, Supreme Court, 638** that “when the vehicle is seized in connection with any offence, the vehicle be released expeditiously”. Thus, considering the aforesaid factual aspects and law laid down in *Sunderbai's* case there is no reason to deny the interim custody of the scooter to the applicant. Besides, it is pertinent to note that if the scooter in question is kept in Police Station in open condition without any care and allowed to be subjected to rain and sun, its condition will be deteriorated and there is every possibility of damage to its spare-parts. For this reason also, it is necessary to grant interim custody of the scooter to the applicant. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.

2. The interim custody of Suzuki Access scooter bearing registration No.MH06/DB-24542 having its Chassis No.MB 8EN11AHS8530051 and Engine No.AF261163667/NA seized in C.R.No.340/2025 registered with Khalapur Police Station, shall be given to the applicant Sudarshan Vasant Sawant on following conditions ;

The applicant shall furnish *supurdnama* in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) before Investigating officer of Khalapur Police Station with condition that he shall produce the scooter in question before this Court at the time of trial and also as and when required & directed by this Court.

The applicant shall not sell, mortgage, transfer or dispose of the scooter in question in any manner and shall not make any change in its body, colour, chassis number and engine number.

Before giving interim custody of the scooter in question to applicant, colour photographs of cabinet size from different clearly angles indicating registration number and other particulars of the scooter in question shall be kept on file and expenses of photographs shall be borne by applicant.

It is made clear that in case of any allegations regarding involvement of said scooter in question in any criminal activities or in transportation of any objectionable articles, the order as to interim release of the scooter in question shall stands vacated automatically.
