

Order below Exh.114 in Sessions Case No.16/2024
(CNR No. MHRT010004272024)

1. By this application, the applicant/accused no.2 Manraj Dattaram Chavan prayed that necessary order be passed for granting permission to him for attending the religious post funeral rituals of his deceased father Dattaram Bhau Chavan on 19/06/2026 and 21/06/2026. It is submitted that his father died on 10/06/2026 at village Nandiwade, Tal. & Dist. Ratnagiri. The post funeral rituals of his father are to be done on 19/06/2026 and 21/06/2026. On 19/06/2026 for the tenth day of the religious function, cutting of hair by Razor is important part of said religious rituals therefore he prayed to allow him for cutting his hair by Razor and also prayed to allow him to attend on the religious ceremonies dated 19/06/2026 and 21/06/2026.

2. Investigating Officer filed his say at Exh.116 and resisted the application and submitted that if the applicant accused No. 2 is allowed to cut his hair with a razor on 19/06/2026 for the tenth day of the religious function, the possibility of some inappropriate incident occurring at that time cannot be ruled out. Therefore, he prayed not to allow the accused no.2 to cut his hair during the religious function and also he prayed that accused no.2 should not be allowed to be present for the functions to be held on 19/06/2026 and 21/06/2026. Finally, it is prayed to reject the application.

3. Heard learned advocate Shri. M. L. Dingankar for

applicant/accused no.2 and learned APP Shri. A. A. Phansekar.

4. The record of case shows that the present applicant/accused no.2 is in jail since his arrest. His father died on 10/06/026. Permission was granted to attend the funeral of his father. Accused no.2 attended the said funeral with police squad and no any inappropriate incident occurred on the part of said accused. I think it is but natural to feel any son to do the post funeral rituals of his father. Therefore, I am of opinion that on the humanitarian grounds permission can be granted to attend the religious ceremonies of his father with condition not to do any illegal act. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application Exh. 114 is allowed.
2. Prison Authority is hereby directed to take the applicant/accused no.2 with the police squad to his house to do post funeral rituals of his deceased father Dattaram Bhau Chavan which are to be held on 19/06/2026 and 21/06/2026 between 08:00 am to 5:00 pm.
3. It is directed to applicant/accused no.2 not to do any illegal act in said religious functions, otherwise strick action will be taken.
4. Applicant/accused no.2 shall deposit the requisite charges/fees of police squad, if any.

5. Inform the concerned accordingly.
