In this claim petition, Claimant Deepak Sonu Kotre is represented by Ld. Adv. Mr.S.S.Tharwal. The respondent no.1 Mr. Ravindra Gudade is driver of Goods Truck No.KA-22-D-2555 which gave dash to the Motor cycle of claimant bearing No. MH-08-AL-1299. The respondent no.2 M/s. Uttkarsh Traders is formal party in this claim petition and the claimant has not made any claim against respondent no.2 in this petition. The respondent no.3 is Insurance Company with which Goods Truck driven by respondent no.1 is insured. The claimant has claimed compensation against respondent no.1 and 3 only in this petition.

2. The notice of petition is served upon respondent no.1 and 2 and as they have not appeared in the petition, petition proceeded ex-parte against both of them. The respondent no.3 has appeared in this petition through Ld. Adv. Mr. A.A. Phansekar.

3. As there were chances of settlement of dispute between rival parties, the petition was referred for Mediation. In the Mediation process, the dispute between claimant and respondent no.3 is amicably settled in terms of compromise pursis at Exh No.40. The report of Mediator to that effect is at Exh. No.39.

4. The claimant remained present before the Court and voluntarily admitted the contents of compromise pursis at Exh.No.40 as true and correct. The claimant is identified by his Ld. Adv. Mr. S. S. Tharwal. The claimant has admitted that the claim petition is settled by him with respondents for compensation of Rs.5,50,000/- (Rs. Five Lakh Fifty Thousand only) voluntarily. The respondent no. 3 is present through its authorized representative as well as advocate Mr. A.A. Phansekar. The respondent no.3 has produced authority letter given by it to Ld. Adv. Mr. A.A.Phansekar authorizing him to settle the claim of claimant for compensation of amount of Rs.5,50,000/-(Rs. Five Lakh Fifty Thousand only) at Exh No.43. It shows that the respondent no.3 has authorized Ld. Adv. Mr. A.A.Phansekar to compromise the claim petition in Mediation process with claimant. Considering these facts, it reveals that the claim petition is amicably settled in terms of compromise pursis at Exh.No.40 between claimant and respondents. Hence, Claim petition deserves to be allowed in terms of compromise pursis at Exh.No.40. Hence, I pass following order :-

ORDER

1. The claim petition is allowed in terms of compromise pursis at Exh No.40.
2. The respondent no.3 shall pay compensation amount of Rs.5,50,000/- (Rs. Five Lakh Fifty Thousand only) to claimant within 45 days from Award passed in this claim petition.

3. The interim applications, if any, pending in this petition shall stands disposed off.
4. The Award be drawn up accordingly.
5. The compromise pursis at Exh.No.40 shall form part and parcel of Award.
