1. This is application filed by the accused/applicant for getting permission to go to abroad for his job. Ld. APP filed his say vide Exh. 14 and strongly objected this application.

2. Accused is facing trial for the offence punishable under Section 8(c), 21(b) of NDPS Act. Accused getting job in Smana Hotel A1 Raffa, 37 A1 Raffa, st, Dubai, 31219, United Arab Emirates as a helper. The accused has to go to there due to the nature of his job and to earn his livelihood and support his family. This case is of 2025. In this case, charge is yet to be framed. Some time will be required in this case for beginning and conclusion of trial. His family resides at Ratnagiri. Thus, his permanent place of residence is Ratnagiri, Maharashtra. He sought permission to go to abroad for his job. In this application itself he has stated that if the trial commences in this case he will not challenge his identity and if during his voyage trial reaches upto recording his

statement under Section 313 of Cr.P.C., then he will remain present for recording that statement. Under these circumstances, he deserves to get permission to go to abroad as a supervisor subject to an undertaking mentioned below. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed conditionally.
2. Applicant is permitted to go to abroad for his job only after framing of charge.
3. His advocate and one family member shall regularly and punctually attend the dates of this case.
4. He shall take due care that his absence from India will not create any hurdle in completing the trial of this case.
5. During evidence his identity shall not be challenged.
6. He shall remain present before this Court as and when directed.
