

Order below Exh. 25 in MACP DARKHAST No. 3/2023
(CNR NO.MHRT 010005412023)

Read application of D.H. Perused record of execution Petition.
Heard Ld. Adv. Mr. Bhatawadekar for D.H.

2. This is the application filed by D.H. to grant permission to pay 50% amount out of the amount deposited by J.D. as per order of Hon'ble Bombay High Court in First Appeal No.1620/2025 dated 08/12/2025 and permit to deposit 50% amount out of it in the Bank account of D.H No.1 and 25% each out of it in the account of DH NO.2 and 3 respectively. The DH have contended in their application that out of the 50% amount directed to be paid to DH by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court from the amount deposited by J.D, the DH No.1 to 3 want to deposit 50% amount out of it in the bank account of DH No.1 and 25% each amount out of it in the bank account of DH No.2 and 3 separately. Accordingly, D.H. have prayed to grant the application.

3. As the award is passed jointly and severally in favour of D.H. No.1 to 3, issue arise in this application about jurisdiction of this Court to divide the compensation amount between D.H.No.1 to 3 and separately deposit 50%, 25% and 25% amount in the separate bank account of D.H. No.1 to 3 respectively. So, the application is kept for argument on that point.

4. In the meantime, D.H.No.1 to 3 have opened their joint bank account in HDFC Bank Ltd. Branch Devrukh bearing account no.30100866877812.

5. Now the Ld. Adv. Mr. Bhatawadekar has argued that as DH No.1 to 3 have opened their joint bank account in HDFC Bank Branch Devrukh, he is not pressing the relief sought in this application that 50% amount payable to DH No.1 be deposited in her separate bank account and 25% each amount payable to DH No.2 and 3 be deposited in their separate bank account. He has further submitted that now the amount payable to DH No.1 to 3 as per order of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in First Appeal No.1620/2025 passed on interim application (ST) No.31005/2025 dated 8/12/2025 may be deposited fully in the joint bank account of DH No.1 to 3.

6. As D.H. No.1 to 3 have opened their joint bank account in HDFC Bank Branch Devrukh, it is proper to pay the amount of 50% out of amount deposited by J.D. in the Execution Petition and interest upon that amount by depositing it in joint bank account in HDFC Bank Branch Devrukh of D.H. No.1 to 3 as per order passed below Exh. No.16 in this case. Hence, I pass following order -

ORDER

1. The application is allowed on following terms :-

- a) As per order of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in First Appeal No. 1620/2025 passed on interim application (ST) No.31005/2025 dated 8/12/2025 and in view of order passed below Exh No. 16 in this case, the amount of 50% out of amount deposited by J.D. in the Execution Petition and interest accrued upon 50% amount be paid to D.H. No.1 to 3 by depositing it in their joint bank account in HDFC Bank Branch Devrukh of D.H.No.1 to 3.

2. A.S (Cash & Finance) shall verify the documents of joint bank account of DH No. 1 to 3 and deposit the amount of compensation as directed above in their joint bank account as per rule.
