J U D G M E N T

1. Accused stands charged with the offence punishable u/s.Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 281 .
2. Accused is present. Requirement u/s.207 Cr.PC was complied with. Particulars of the offences were read over and explained to the accused to which he pleaded guilty. I accept the plea since I am convinced of its genuineness and that the same is made voluntarily. Hence, I find the accused guilty of the offence punishable u/s.Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 281 and convicted thereunder. Accordingly, the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹.500 for the offence u/s. Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 281 and in default; to undergo simple imprisonment for 5 days.
