ORDER BELOW EXH.01

1. The matter is taken on today's board for its consideration in the special drive of this week. This is complaint filed against accused for the offence punishable under section 341, 504, 506 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code. The record reveals that the case is instituted on otherwise than upon a police report and is triable as a summons case. The matter has been pending before this court since 06.11.2019. Since then there is no progress in the matter. Despite several opportunities, the complainant has failed to take steps. The complainant is absent since long time. Presence of accused also not secured. It appears that further continuation of the proceeding would not serve the ends of justice and would amount to unnecessary prolongation of the trial. No application for exemption or adjournment is filed. It appears that the complainant is not interested in prosecuting the complaint. In view of the absence of the complainant and having regard to the provisions of Section 256 of the Cr.P.C., this court has no option but to dismiss the complaint. Hence, following order is passed.

ORDER

1. The complaint stands dismissed for want of prosecution u/s. 256 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
2. The accused is acquitted of the offence punishable 341, 504, 506 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. Bail bonds of the accused stand cancelled.
