JUDGMENT

The accused is charge-sheeted for the offence p/u/s. 185 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988.

Brief facts of the case as follows:-

2. On 02/06/2026 at about 21.43 at Bahadurshekh Naka, Tal-Chiplun Dist. Ratnagiri you were found driving Motorcycle vehicle No. MH-08 AB- 9169 under the influence of liquor to such an extent as to be incapable of exercising proper control over the vehicle, and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 185 of the Motor Vehicle Act.

3. The particulars of substance of accusation were read & explained to the accused in Marathi. After that accused voluntarily pleaded guilty for the offence p/u/s. 185 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988.

4. Before acting upon the plea of the accused the status as to voluntariness of the statement made at the time of plead guilty is to be ascertained for the purpose of voluntariness I cautioned the accused by giving information that his statement may be used against him and he be convicted on the basis of his statement. Even on so cautioning of

consequences the accused remained firm to his statement. Hence, I am satisfied that he has voluntarily pleaded guilty. Hence, ingredients essential for purpose of proving offence defined p/u/s. 185 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 are hereby established. Hence, accused deserves to be convicted. Here, I stop to hear the accused on the point of sentence. The accused submitted that, it is the first offence his family is depending upon him. Hence, leniency be shown. I am of the opinion that offence p/u/s. 185 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 is punishable with for the first offence with imprisonment for the term which may extend to six months or with fine which extends to Rs. 10,000/- or with both. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and no previous antecedents of the accused. Hence, a sentence of fine instead of sentencing him to imprisonment will mitigate the ends of the justice. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The accused **Sandip Yashwant Gamare** is hereby convicted vide section 275 of B.N.S.S. for the offence p/u/s. 185 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and sentenced to pay fine of **Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand Rupees only)** and in default of which to suffer simple imprisonment for **one month**.
2. Copy of judgment be given free of Cost to the accused.
