COMMITMENT ORDER:

The present accused has been sent by Station House Officer, Arya Nagar, Rohtak to face trial for commission of offence punishable under Sections 195-A, 294, 506, 509 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC').

2. In brief the prosecution story is that complainant Seema wife of Ravi moved an application before the police alleging therein that on 12.04.2022, the complainant came to court to give testimony in a rape case against Amit s/o Naresh, resident of Village Nilothe, District Jhajjar, pending in the court of Ms. Gagangeet Kaur, Rohtak and outside the

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courtroom, Accused Amit verbally abused her, called her derogatory words and threatened to kill her whenever he get the chance. Mainly with these allegations, the complainant prayed for taking legal action against the accused

3. On the basis of aforesaid statement, FIR was lodged under sections Sections 354-A and 506 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC'). During investigation, Section 354-A IPC was deleted and Section 195-A, 294 and 509 of IPC was added. Special reports were sent to the higher officers, Site plan of place of occurrence was prepared. Proceedings under Section 174 Cr.P.C was done. Statements of witnesses were recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C. Accused were arrested. Disclosure statements of accused recorded. On completion of investigation, Report under section 173 of Cr.P.C. was presented before the court.

4. Complete copy of challan was supplied to the accused free of costs as required under section 207 of Code of Criminal Procedure.

5. From the perusal of the police report, it is revealed that the accused have been challaned under sections Sections 195-A, 294, 506, 509 of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC'). In view of the facts of the present case, the offence punishable under Section 195-A IPC is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions, the case is committed to the Court of Hon'ble Sessions Judge, Rohtak for 30.07.2026. The accused Amit is directed to appear before the Court of Hon'ble Sessions Judge, Rohtak on the said date at 10:00A.M. sharp. The commitment order has

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been dictated in the presence of learned APP for the State, who has been notified about the commitment of the case. The Public Prosecutor in the Sessions Court stands notified through the ld. A.P.P. of this Court. Reader is directed to prepare calandera. Ahlmad is directed to send the case file complete in all respects to the Court of Hon'ble Sessions Judge, Rohtak, well within time.
