This is a proceeding for maintenance as per section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('the Code' for short).

02. By the present application, the applicant wife has prayed for directing the non-applicant to produce his latest pay slip. It is contended that, earlier the non-applicant has produced the photocopy of pay slip. However, for the purpose of justice in the matter, it is necessary to direct him to produce pay slip of October 2024.

03. Application is strongly opposed by the non-applicant by filling reply at Exh. 63. It is contended that, due to failure of the applicant to adduce further evidence, her evidence is closed by the Court. Present application is made when the matter was posted for final arguments. It is not tenable. Thus, it is liable to be rejected.

04. Perused the record. Heard both sides.

05. Pertinently, the quantum of maintenance allowances, if any, to be granted depends on the income source of the parties. For the sake of justice, therefore, if latest pay slip is produced by the non-applicant, he would suffer no harm or loss. On the other hand, it would help in reaching just decision in the case. Hence, the application deserves to be allowed. Therefore, I pass following order -

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. The non-applicant is directed to produce is pay slip for the months of October 2024 and November 2024.
