

**RECORDING OF STATEMENT UNDER
SECTION.164 OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
CODE**

The complainant police filed the requisition seeking recording of victim statement. Office is hereby directed to register Crl. Misc and put up the order sheet.

Office has registered the Crl. Misc case and put up the order sheet.

Victim namely Prarthana, D/o A.C. Prasannakumar, Aged about 14 years, C/o Vijaya House, Near Indira Canteen N.S. Road, Near Government School, Old Byappanahalli, Bengaluru is present and submits that she is eager to give her statement, same has been recorded for the offences punishable U/s 376 of IPC, U/s 5(J)(II),(5)(I),6 Protection of children from sexual offence Act-2012 .

All the police personnel are sent out of court, Advocates and General public are requested to go out of the court. I have explained the victim about the consequences of giving statement. It is also made known to her that, her statement may be used as evidence against her in future.

On enquiry, the victim is making statement voluntarily and not influenced by any one. I am also satisfied that, victim is giving statement under oath is voluntarily one and not influenced or biased by anybody i.e., police or other persons. It is also explained to her that, she should make statement voluntarily.

The statement of victim is recorded for the offence punishable U/s 376 of IPC, U/s 5(J)(II),(5)(I),6 Protection of children from sexual offence Act-2012 in Cr.No.0063/2023 of Byappanahalli P.S. also victim statement is recorded at 2.30 P.M. to 3.00 P.M. in open court in, in-camera proceedings during this time the police and staff were sent out and only Myself and Typist were present.

In open court, two sets of victim statement has been taken out and obtained signatures of victim on both sets.

Office to send the victim statement in sealed cover for further action to **Hon'ble FTSC-III, Bengaluru.**

Further the Inspector has filed a requisition for a copy of 164 statement for further investigation. In view

of requisition one copy of this statement has been served to Inspector of **Byappanahalli P.S.** with a direction to not to disclose the 164 statement till filing of charge sheet.

164(5) Cr.P.C. statement has been recorded, hence case is closed.
