ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

On perusal of record it appears that, complainant remained absent and has not taken any steps to proceed the case. The complainant has to take stringent steps, it is not expected the lethargy of complainant in doing so. The complainant is also consecutively remained absent from the proceedings of this case despite of several opportunities had been given. The complainant neither remained present nor showed cause for absence through his Ld. Advocate or anyone else. Therefore, the matter is kept for dismissal order on 05/03/2026. However, till today the complainant failed to take any steps in the matter. Today also, complainant is absent when called out. She has not taken any steps.

02. It is important to note that, various times the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Hon'ble High Court, issued directions in respect of disposal of stale and ineffective cases. The present case is more than two years old. No fruitful purpose will be served by keeping the case pending any more in absence of any step taken by the complainant. Considering the nature of present case, it is a fit case for dismissed in default. Hence, I pass following order :-
