2. Arguments heard on application for pre-mature release of convict Kuldeep @ Kalu son of Vinod Kumar Nagpal resident of House no. 1-H/50, NIT Faridabad.

3. Learned counsel for applicant has prayed for release of applicant/convict in terms of directions issued by Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana in COCP no. 2020-2022. As per reply of the jail authority received today, applicant Kuldeep was convicted & Sentenced by the Court of Sh. A.K Raghava, the then learned Additional Sessions Judge (I) Faridabad vide order dated 14.02.2007 to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life and to pay fine Rs. 6000/- (in default of payment of fine to undergo further RI for 01 year & 01 months) in case FIR no. 1041 dated 18.12.2004 U/S 364-A, 302, 201, 120B, 404 IPC (Sentenced under Section 302 IPC, 201 IPC & 364-A IPC PS NIT, Faridabad). Fine has not been paid. The convict preferred an appeal before Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana in CRA 296-DB of 2007 which was dismissed by Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 30.04.2013.

4. The case for pre-mature release of convict was sent to office of DGP Haryana vide letter no. 1734 dated 16.02.2026 for consideration which is still pending. As per the jail authorities, the convict is eligible for pre-mature release on interim bail as per directions of Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana in COCP no. 2020-2022 titled 'Pawan Kumar versus D.K Tiwari & Anr', because he has completed his requisite sentence i.e. 25 years after having been given benefit of under trial period, excluding parole period and earned remission as on 31.03.2026.

5. Therefore, in view of above mentioned facts, convict Kuldeep @ Kalu son of Vinod Kumar Nagpal resident of House no. 1-H/50, NIT Faridabad is ordered to be released on interim bail as part of his pre-mature release in view of the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana in COCP no. 2020-2022. He is directed to **furnish bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount.** His pre-mature release is **subject to the condition as follows:-**

1. An undertaking by family member of convict that in event of pre-mature release case of such a convict is rejected by the government, he/she will surrender back to the concerned jail to undergo further imprisonment;
2. The passport of such a convict, if any, till the time final decision is taken by the competent authority, will remain deposited with the local police where FIR was registered or with the Court and such person will not be permitted to travel abroad without the prior permission of the Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned;
3. The convict shall not change his address without intimation to this court and shall give prior intimation before changing his address alongwith complete details and proof.

6. In view of my forgoing observation and discussion, application interim bail (premature release) of applicant/convict is disposed off accordingly. **Bonds not furnished.** File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
