State Vs. Abhijeet.

Present: Sh. Ravinder Kumar, APP for the State.
Accused **Abhijeet** in custody represented by Sh. Ashok Kumar,
Legal aid counsel for remand hours.

Above named accused produced before me in custody being area Magistrate for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 21 and 29 of NDPS Act. Taken on record. On asking of this court, accused person conveyed that he is having knowledge about grounds of arrest.

An application for seeking police remand of accused **Abhijeet** for 10 days has been moved by IO. Perusal of the documents accompanied with the application for police remand reveals that the arrest was made on **12.08.2026**. Therefore, there is no ground to disbelieve the date of arrest shown by the police.

Furthermore, on perusal of the case record, it is evident that all the legal formalities regarding the arrest of the accused vide Section 47, 35, 48 and 51 of B.N.S.S., 2023 have been complied with. On perusal of medical report appended with the file revealed that no fresh injury is there on the person of the accused.

An application seeking Police remand of accused Abhijeet for 10 days for recovery of remaining amount of Rs.2500/- earned by selling Chitta Smack from the iron cupboard kept in a room in the house of accused and for arresting the co accused Bittu, Rajan and Shimari from Chandigarh by conducting raid and for custodial investigation. Heard on Police Remand.

On perusal and hearing upon the application, the court is satisfied that the accusation is prima facie well founded. Keeping in view the principle of the complete and fair investigation for bringing out the true facts, this court opines that **07 days' Police custody of the accused Abhijeet is allowed.** Hence,

the above-named accused is hereby remanded to police custody till **20.08.2026**
Accused **Abhijeet** is directed to be produced before the Court on **20.08.2026**.

1. Investigating Officer is directed to get the accused persons medically examined in every 24 hours, in compliance of provisions of Section 53 B.N.S.S.2023.
2. Police shall not use third degree method to the accused.
3. The advocate for the accused will be allowed to meet him during the investigation though not through-out the investigation.
4. Police is directed to make available the basic need of life to the accused during the period of police custody.

Last zimni No.6 seen, signed and returned. A copy of the order be forwarded to the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat, in compliance of provisions contained in Section 187 of B.N.S.S. 2023. DDR entry from local police station from recovery to be effected be also placed on file on **20.08.2026**.
