ORDER BELOW EXH.1

The Criminal Revision Application is pending for hearing since last many years. After perusal of the record, it reveals that, the matter has been repeatedly listed for hearing. However, despite of sufficient opportunity neither the revisionist nor his Ld. Advocate has effected the meaningful argument for considerable period. Therefore, the matter cannot be kept pending indefinitely merely because the revisionist has chosen not to prosecute the proceeding. At the same time, having regard to the nature of Criminal Proceedings and consequences which may follow from dismissal of a Criminal Revision, this Court to require exercise due caution before treating the revision as abandoned.

2. The record shows that reasonable opportunity has been afforded to the revisionist. There is no material before the Court indicating sufficient cause for his continues absence or any steps taken by him to prosecute the revision. Under such circumstances this Court is satisfied that, the revisionist is not interested in prosecuting the application. Therefore, with this abundant precaution, the last opportunity is given to the revisionist, falling which the matter will be decided on merit on the next date.
