Accused is absent.
Process Server HC Mukesh is present.

Statement of Process Server HC Mahesh Kumar who executed the process u/s 84 BNSS against accused Izhaar is recorded. I have perused the report and also considered the statement of process server. I am satisfied that the process u/s 84 BNSS has been duly executed as per law against accused but the accused is concealing himself and evading process of law.

Ld. APP for the State submits that since accused is absconding, no movable/ immovable property of accused would be traceable. In view of the same, this Court is of the considered opinion that issuance of process u/s 85 BNSS would be a futile exercise.

In these circumstances, accused Izhaar s/o Sh. Sabbir Ahamad is declared as Proclaimed Person u/s 84 BNSS. Intimation be sent to concerned PS about this fact.

At this stage, Ld. APP for the State submits that the witnesses which are to be examined in the present case are police witnesses and their presence can be secured later. Heard. Statement of these witnesses u/s 299 Cr.P.C. is dispensed with.

Let the file be consigned to Record Room with direction to the Incharge, Record Room (Criminal) to preserve the record as accused Izhaar is absconding in this case and the present case be revived as and when the said accused is apprehended or surrenders before the Court.
