3. Whether the Plaintiff further proves that the power of attorney dated 11.06.2010 and the release deed dated 09.10.2014 executed by his father in favour of Defendants is null and void?
4. Whether the Defendants no. 1 and 2 prove that the plaintiff's father executed a will dated 23.12.1998 about his share in favour of Bhikaji Sakharam Parsekar and after Bhikaji the said property was succeeded by his wife ie. Defendant no. 1?
5. Whether the Plaintiff is entitled for relief of partition as prayed for?
6. Whether the Plaintiff is entitled for the relief of declaration of nullifying the release deed and power of attorney as prayed for?
7. Whether the Plaintiff is entitled for the relief of perpetual injunction as prayed for?
8. What order and decree?
