01. On 22/06/2020 I was attached with Rural Hospital, Deogad as Medical Officer. On that day, I have examined Chandrakant Tukaram Shivgan. He has given history of assault. He has having following two injuries-

- 1) Contusion on left forearm 3X3 c.m.
- 2) Contusion on left side of abdomen 2X2 c.m.

02. Nature of injuries are simple. By hitting blunt and hard object this type of injuries can be sustained. Accordingly, I have issued MLC certificate. Now, the Medico Legal Certificate is now shown to me. It is the same. It bears my signature. It's contents are true and correct. It is at **Exhibit P2/PW5.**

03. On the same day second patient namely, Yogesh Chandrakant Shivgan also came for treatment. I have examined him. He has given history of assault. I found following injuries on him.

- 1) Contusion on left side of elbow joint 2X2 c.m.
- 2) Swelling at groin region 1X1 c.m.

04. Nature of injuries are simple. Accordingly, I have issued MLC certificate. Now, the Medico Legal Certificate is now shown to me. It is the same. It bears my signature. It's contents are true and correct. It is at **Exhibit P3/PW5.**

05. On the same day third patient namely, Sujata Chandrakant Shivgan also came for treatment. I have examined him. She has given history of assault. I found following injuries on him.

1) Abrasion on left side of forearm 2X2 c.m.

06. Nature of injury is simple. Accordingly, I have issued MLC certificate. Now, the Medico Legal Certificate is now shown to me. It is the same. It bears my signature. It's contents are true and correct. It is at **Exhibit P4/PW5.**

07. It is true to say that all injuries referred in examination-in-chief are simple in nature. It is true to say that if person falls on hard surface, such types of injuries can be sustained. It is true to say that my MLC certificates do not explain the history of injuries i.e. how they were sustained. It is true to say that all medical certificates have not disclosed that all patients have referred to me by police officials along with Yadi. Hence, it is correct to say that these cannot be considered as medical legal cases.
