Firstly, that you all accused persons, on 29/10/2023 at about 5.30 to 6.30 p.m., at infront of Talashil Tondavali in Arabian sea at Chinmayprasad Trawler bearing No. IND-MH-5-MM-2728 and boat bearing No. IND-MH-4-MM-1513 in prosecution of your common object, to commit offence were member of an unlawful assembly and

thereby you have committed an offence punishable under **Section 143 r.w. Section 149** of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

Secondly, that you all accused persons, on the above said date, time and place, in prosecution of your common object, committed the offence of rioting and thereby you have committed an offence punishable under **Section 147 r.w. Section 149** of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

Thirdly, that you all accused persons, on the above said date, time and place, in prosecution of your common object, were members of an unlawful assembly and were at the time armed with a deadly weapon i.e. knife, iron pipe, cement stone, wooden sticks when used as weapon of offence is likely to cause death and thereby you have committed an offence punishable under **Section 148 r.w. Section 149** of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

Fourthly, that you all accused persons, on the above said date, time and place, in prosecution of your common object, voluntarily caused hurt to informant for the purpose of extorting from the informant's property namely fishing material/implements i.e. fish finder, fishing net, hydraulic winch, monitor, wireless set, 200 liter diesel, GPS, battery, twenty still rings, cash and five mobile phone and thereby you have committed an offence punishable under **Section 327 r.w. Section 149** of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

Fifthly, that you all accused persons, on the above said date, time and place, in prosecution of your common object, voluntarily caused hurt to the informant's labours Raj Choudhari, Sumit Dangoura,

Vinay horo, Sanjay Aadivarekar, Gabriel Lakra, Jaydas Dorlekar by means of iron pipe, wooden sticks, knief which used as a weapon of offence is likely to cause death and thereby you have committed an offence punishable under **Section 324 r.w. Section 149** of Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

Sixthly, that you all accused persons, on the above said date, time and place, in prosecution of your common object, voluntarily caused hurt to the Raj Choudhari, Sumit Dangoura, Vinay horo, Sanjay Aadivarekar, Gabriel Lakra, Jaydas Dorlekar and thereby you have committed an offence punishable under **Section 323 r.w. Section 149** of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

Seventhly, that you all accused persons, on the above said date, time and place, in prosecution of your common object, you have committed mischief by causing damage to the informant's fishing fishing material/implements, i.e. fish finder, fishing net, hydraulic winch, monitor, ice, diesel and caused damage more than 50/- rupees and thereby you have committed an offence punishable under **Section 427 r.w. Section 149** of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

Lastly, that you all accused persons, on the above said date, time and place, in prosecution of your common object, knowing or having reason to believe that the offence punishable with Section 327, 427 r.w. 149 has been committed caused certain evidence connected with the said offence namely fish finder, wireless set, GPS, batteries, steel rings to disappear with intention to screen the offender from legal punishment and thereby you have committed an offence

punishable under **Section 201 r.w.149** of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by me on the above said charge.
