Read the plaint. Perused the temporary injunction application supported by an affidavit. Heard Ld. advocate on behalf of plaintiff. Perused the documents in the support of plaint as well as application. After perusing the plaint, I am of the view that, this is not a fit case for the purpose of granting exparte ad-interim relief in favour of plaintiff or for granting status-quo order. An opportunity of being heard needs to be given to the defendant Nos. 1 and 2 to arrive at a proper conclusion. Plaintiff's prayer may be considered after defendant Nos. 1 and 2 appears. Therefore, it would be just and proper to issue show-cause notices to defendant Nos. 1 and 2. Thus I proceed to pass following order.:

ORDER

Issue show-cause notices to the defendant Nos. 1 and 2 as to why temporary injunction order should not be granted in favour of plaintiff, r/o. 06/04/2018.
