Following order is passed**ORDER**

1. This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail under section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
2. Court perused the application and the reply filed. Heard the Ld Adv. Mr. Jeetendra Tiwari for the applicant/accused and APP Smt. Usha Jadhav for State present.
3. There is prima facie material against the applicant/accused to have involved in the offence by the FIR. Though it is so, nature of the offence, is such that evidence can be straight way led before the Court. Nothing is to be seized or recovered from the applicant/ accused. He is resident of Kajupada, Mumbai-72 and can be available for the trial. There are no criminal antecedents against him. He may threaten the informant but that has to be taken care of by suitable terms and conditions. Hence, following order.

ORDER

1. Anticipatory Bail Application No. 1611 of 2021 is conditionally allowed.
2. In the event of arrest, in aforesaid C.R No. 1117/2021 for the offences punishable under sections 354, 506, 509 of The Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered with Sakinaka Police Station, applicant/accused Nasir Mohammed @ Saddam Sayyed be released on his executing P. R. Bond of Rs 15,000/-(Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) and on furnishing solvent surety of like amount and on accepting and complying following terms and conditions -
 - a) He shall not tamper with prosecution witnesses in any way.
 - b) He shall produce his Identity Card, address proof and furnish his mobile number with bail papers.
 - c) He shall attend concerned Police Station from 01.01.2022 to 15.01.2022 on every alternate day between 11.00 a.m. - 1.00 p.m. and shall co-operate in the investigation and thereafter if the investigating officer calls for till the end of February, 2022 or till filing of the charge-sheet whichever is earlier.
 - d) He shall maintain the diary of attendance.
 - e) He shall attend the trial regularly.
 - f) He shall not commit similar offence during on bail period.
