



ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 91 IN R.C.S. NO. 25/2014

Heard. Read the application.

2] The plaintiffs have moved the present application for substituted service of suit summons on the defendants No. 2A vide order 5, rule 20 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

3] Perused the record. The record shows that service of suit summons on the defendants No.2A was attempted by regular mode. But it returned unserved with remark that defendant No. 2A resides at Kandalgaon. Even after issuing of suit summons on defendant No.2A at Kandalgaon address it returned unserved with remark she is not residing at that address. It is contended by the plaintiffs that they are unable to obtain the address of defendants No.2A even after due inquiry. Plaintiff No.1 has filed an affidavit in support of the application. The bailiff report clearly shows that the summons cannot be served on defendants No.2A by regular mode. The satisfactory reasons are borne on record to believe that the defendants No. 2A could not be served by usual mode. In view of the above circumstances his submissions are liable to be accepted. In view of this, it is necessary to issue summons vide order 5, rule 20(1A) of C.P.C. Hence, following order is passed.

ORDER

The suit summons be served on the defendants No.2A by an advertisement in a daily edition newspaper, having wide circulation in the locality in which defendant No. 2A is last known to have resided or carried on business or actually worked for gain vide

order 5, rule 20 (1A) of the C.P.C. returnable on

In addition to the above mode a copy of suit summons shall also be affixed on a conspicuous part of the Court house.

The plaintiffs shall bear the costs of publication.

The plaintiffs shall file a copy of publication and an affidavit of compliance.
