Read the application alongwith the say filed by the defendants. The plaintiff has preferred the present application and sought permission to reopen the evidence of the plaintiff. The plaintiff has filed certificate issued u/s.65-B of the Indian Evidence Act alongwith list at Exh.32. It is well settled that copy of the electronic record needs to be filed alongwith the certificate issued u/s.65-B of the Indian Evidence Act. It is also well settled that the defect of certificate can be cured at any stage of the proceeding. Therefore, in order to cure the said defect, the plaintiff needs to be permitted to reopen the evidence. Hence, the application filed by the plaintiff is liable to be allowed. Accordingly I pass following order.

ORDER

The application at Exh.30 is hereby allowed and the plaintiff is permitted to reopen his evidence. The plaintiff is directed to conclude their evidence within the period of two months from the date of order without fail.
