The present application has been filed by the plaintiff seeking permission to publish a notice in the Ratnagiri Times, Sindhudurg editions.

2. It is the contention of the plaintiff that defendant No. 2, expired. The plaintiff states that he has made efforts to find the legal representatives of the deceased defendant but was unable to trace them. Therefore, in the interest of justice and to ascertain the whereabouts and legal representatives of defendant No. 2, it is necessary to issue a public notice in the newspapers so that they may come to know about the pendency of Regular Civil Suit No. 74/2022.

3. The plaintiff has stated that, despite due diligence, he could not find the legal heirs. The application is supported by an affidavit. Hence, it would be just and proper to allow publication of such notice in the newspapers as prayed for. However, in addition to newspaper publication, a copy of the notice shall also be affixed at a conspicuous place on the house where defendant No. 2 last resided, and another copy shall be affixed on the notice board of the Court. Hence following order,

1.	Application at Exh. 61 is allowed.

2.	Plaintiff is permitted to publish the notice in Ratnagiri Times, Sindhudurg editions.
3.	A copy of the notice shall also be affixed at the last known residence of defendant No. 2 and on the Court's notice board.
4.	No order as to costs.
