

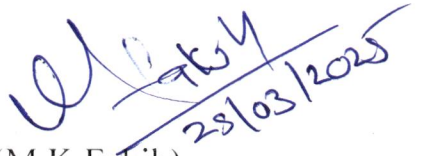
Order below Exh.63

Present application has been filed by legal representatives of the deceased plaintiff to bring them on record. The other side resisted the application by filing say on the overleaf of the application itself.

- 2] Perused the record. Heard both sides.
- 3] The plaintiff is reported to have died on 18.09.2024.
- 4] The suit is for declaration and permanent injunction. The deceased plaintiff is survived by a widow, one daughter and four sons. The application is supported by an affidavit. The suit is in respect of immovable properties, therefore the right to sue survives. The application is made within limitation. Therefore application deserves to be allowed. Hence following order,

3	The plaintiff should file amended plaint on record on or before next date.
