This is an application filed by the applicant for grant of Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation Act 1827.

2. **Brief facts of the application are as under**

Pandurang Krishnaji Tandel was the owner of Motorcycle bearing registration No. MH-07-AD-3295 and the same was registered in his name. Pandurang Krishnaji Tandel expired on 13/07/2024. The applicant is the wife of the deceased Bipin Suryakant Satalkar. Respondent no. 1 and 2 are daughters and respondent no. 3 is son of deceased Pandurang Krishnaji Tandel. After the death of Pandurang Krishnaji Tandel, applicant and respondents herein are the only legal representatives to him. Therefore in order to change the ownership of the said motorcycle in the record of RTO, Sindhudurg, the applicant is in need of a heirship certificate.

3. The applicants have not filed any application other than this present application in any other court with respect to the subject matter of this application. The applicants herein are the only legal heirs of the deceased Pandurang Krishnaji Tandel. The applicant further states that, there is no impediment to grant Heirship certificate

under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation Act 1827. Hence, the applicant prayed to grant the Heirship Certificate in the name of applicant.

4. The respondents, vide their say at Exh. 14, have raised no objection to the application being granted as prayed for.

5. The objection to this application was called by issuance of public notice Exh.11 in daily newspaper “Dainik Prahar” on 27/12/2025. After issuance of the said notice, no one appeared before this Court raising objection in respect of the present application.

6. Heard the learned counsel on behalf of the applicants. Perused record. Following points arises for my determination and I have recorded my findings thereon as under ;

**REASONS****AS TO POINT NO(s). 1 TO 3**

7. To prove the claim, the applicants have filed applicant's affidavit at Exh. 15. She reiterated all the facts stated in the application and produced the certain documentary evidence on record namely i) Death Certificate of deceased at Exh.17. ii) Copy of RC of the said motorcycle bearing registration No. MH-07-AD-3295 iii) Letter dated 28/11/2025 issued by RTO Sindhudurg at Exh.16. Lastly, the applicant closed their her of evidence by filing pursis at Exh.21.

8. The respondent no. 1 to 3 did not adduce any evidence and filed their evidence close pursis at Exh.22.

9. Perused the record. The applicant has examined herself at Exh.15. Her oral evidence is the verbatim reproduction of the contentions in the application. The documentary evidence filed vide list Exh.4, and 19 are proved in the applicant's affidavit in lieu of examination in chief at Exh.15. The death certificate Exh.17 shows that deceased Pandurang Krishnaji Tandel expired on 13/07/2024.

10. From the affidavit filed at Exh.15 coupled with aforesaid documentary evidence, it has been proved that the parties herein are the legal heir of deceased Bipin

Suryakant Satalkar. No one appeared before this Court raising objection in respect of the present application. Accordingly, it has come on record that, the applicants being the legal heirs of deceased Bipin Suryakant Satalkar are entitled for the heirship certificate in respect of motorcycle bearing registration No. MH-07-AD-3295. The respondent nos 1 to 3 have no objection to issuing heirship certificate in the name of the applicant no.1.

11. Moreover the entire case and all the evidence adduced by the applicant has remained unchallenged. The oral evidence adduced by the applicant is duly corroborated by the documentary evidence. There appears no reason to disbelieve the same. Hence, I answer the point nos. 1 and 2 in the affirmative and as to point no.3 pass following order :

<b><u>ORDER</u></b>	
1.	Civil MA. No. 44/2025 is allowed.
2.	Issue Heirship Certificate in the name of applicant Smt. Pallavi Pandurang Tandel in respect of motorcycle bearing registration No. MH-07-AD-3295.
3.	The applicant shall pay necessary Court Fees as per rules.

4.	On payment of Court fees, the heirship Certificate be issued in the name of applicant forthwith, as prayed for.
