This is an application preferred by the plaintiff under Order 6 Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

2. The plaintiff has contended that due to some typographical error was occurred, therefore, it is necessary to correct the said error. Therefore, prayed to allow the plaintiff to carry out proposed amendment. The intended amendment will not change the nature of the suit. Therefore, prayed to allow the application.

3. The defendants have filed say on overleaf of the application and resisted the application. It is contended that the application is false and frivolous, therefore, prayed to reject the application.

4. Heard both sides. Both the parties have reiterated the contents of application and say. The error appears to occur due to typo mistake. The proposed amendment is not inconsistent with the earlier pleadings of the plaintiff. The intended amendment is of formal in nature. It will not change the nature of the suit. Moreover, the present application is preferred when the matter is posted for the plaintiff's evidence. The plaintiff has yet to be adduced his evidence, therefore, no prejudice will be caused to the defendant. Therefore, the plaintiff needs to be

permitted to carryout the proposed amendment. Thus, the application filed by the plaintiff is liable to be allowed and accordingly, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. The application at **Exh.20** is hereby allowed.
2. The plaintiff shall carry out amendment on or before next date from the date of order and provide amended copy of plaint to defendant free of Costs.
