ORDER

1. Ld. APP present. All the accused persons along with their Counsel present. Perusal of the challan reveals that the accused persons are involved in case FIR No. 162/2022 of P/S Reasi for the commission of offences U/S 379/34 IPC.
2. The complainant in this case namely Balwant Chand S/O Nanak Chand R/O Patta Reasi also present in the Court. The complainant and accused persons have jointly submitted an application for compounding of the offences U/S 379/34 IPC with permission to compound the offence U/S 379 IPC on the ground that they have amicably resolved the dispute outside the Court and are no longer interested in the prosecution of the case. As per complainant, the cow which is a subject matter of theft has no value. To this extent, the statements of the complainant and accused persons have been recorded. Be placed on record. The complainant is identified by Naib Courty and the accused persons are identified by their Counsel.
3. Since the instant challan pertains to the offences punishable U/S 379/34 IPC and the offence U/S 379 IPC is compoundable in nature with permission, therefore the permission to compound the offence U/S 379 IPC is granted and since the offences U/S 379/34 IPC being compoundable in nature, the Challan, as such, stands disposed off as compounded. Accused persons are acquitted of the charges leveled against them. Bail bonds and personal bonds furnished by the accused persons stands discharged. File after its due compilation shall be consigned to records.
