Drug Inspector, Sindhudurg Nagari ..... **Applicant**

An application has been moved by the Drug Inspector above named, under Section 23(5)(b) of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, informing this Court regarding the seizure of certain drugs and seeking orders for their safe custody.

02. It is contended by applicant that he is appointed as Drugs Inspector under section 33-G of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940. Having office at Assistant Commissioner, Food and Drug Administration, Main Administrative Building, A-Block, Ground Floor, Sindhudurg Nagari, Dist. Sindhudurg -416812.

03. On dated 30/12/2025, applicant visited and searched the firm M/s. Amrut Vishnu Ayurveda, H.No.788, Bazarpeth, A/P.Deogad, Tal. Deogad, Dist. Sindhudurg. Applicant has found that the owner of M/s. Amrut Vishnu Ayurveda namely Pramod Hari Nalawade without having license to manufacture Ayurvedic Drugs stored, Ayurvedic drug products of Hariamrut Tail (19 bottles of 100 ml and 17 bottles of 200ml) and Kesamrut Tail ( 19 bottles of 100 ml and 6 bottles of 200ml ) for exhibition or offer for sale. Hence, by following procedure prescribed in the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and rules thereunder 1945,

applicant has seized Ayurvedic drugs under Form No.16. Also has taken samples of Ayurvedic drugs in Form No.17 attached with this application. Total amount of seized muddemal is 12,980/-.

04. The details of the seized stock are as per the Form No.16 attached along with this application.

05. The Drugs Inspector has requested that the custody of seized stock and one printed board having descriptions of Hariamrut Tail and Kesamrut Tail as mentioned in Form No.16 may be granted in favour of applicant and allow to keep the seized stock of Ayurvedic drugs, board, printed labels in the office of the Assistant Commissioner, Food and Drugs Administration (MS), Main Administrative Building, A-Block, Ground Floor, Sindhudurg Nagari, Dist. Sindhudurg-416812.

06. Perused the documents filed along with application and the Seizure Memo i.e. Form No.16. The details of the seized stock are as per the Form No.16 attached along with this application. After hearing the Drug Inspector and considering the nature of the property, in view of section 23(5)(B) of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, I proceed to pass following order.

### **Order**

1. Applicant i.e. The Drug Inspector is permitted to retain the custody of the seized stock as mentioned in Form No.16 attached along with this application.

2. The stock shall be kept in a secured, sealed condition at Assistant Commissioner, Food and Drugs Administration (MS), Main Administrative Building, A-Block, Ground Floor, Sindhudurg Nagari, Dist. Sindhudurg - 416812 under the personal responsibility of the applicant.
3. The applicant is directed to ensure that the storage conditions i.e. temperature, humidity, etc. are maintained as per the label requirements of the drugs to prevent deterioration.
4. The seized stock shall be produced before this Court as and when required for trial or further proceedings.
5. A copy of the detailed inventory and the panchanama be kept on the record of this Court.
6. In view of order application is disposed of.
