This CMP has been heard on this day, and the Court on the same day, passed the following:-

**ORDER**

This is the bail application filed by the petitioner /accused u/s 480 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 through his Counsel.

2. The offences alleged against the petitioner / accused are punishable u/ss. 296(b), 126(2), 74 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The prosecution case in brief is as follows:- Due to the enmity towards the defacto complainant that she refused to continue love affair with the accused, the accused with the necessary intention, on 28/05/2026 at 10.30 a.m., at Valiyavazhi Junction in Keezharoor Village, wrongfully restrained the defacto complainant and uttered obscene word against her. Further, the accused forcefully held the left wrist of the defacto complainant and pulled her. Due to the aforementioned act of the accused, the defacto complainant suffered mental agony and her modesty also got outraged. Thus, the accused had committed the offences



aforementioned.

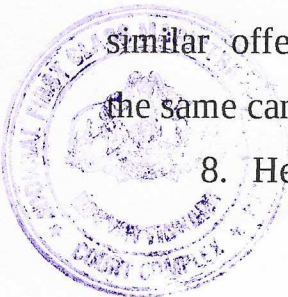
4. The petitioner /accused was arrested and produced before this Court on 29/05/2026 and he was remanded to judicial custody. Since then, he is in judicial custody.

5. Copy of bail application was served to the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. The investigating officer filed report objecting the grant of bail, stating that the petitioner /accused may influence the witnesses, if he is released on bail at this progressive stage of the investigation. Further, if the petitioner / accused is released on bail, he would commit similar offences and may abscond delaying process of law.

6. Heard the Learned Counsel for the petitioner /accused and the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. The Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor strongly opposed the bail application reiterating the contents of the bail objection report. To the contrary, the Learned Counsel for the petitioner /accused contended that the petitioner / accused is innocent and he was falsely implicated in the instant case.

7. On considering the rival contentions and perusal of relevant records, this Court is satisfied that the Investigating Authority has got ample time to conduct investigation and no custody application is pending now, and the investigating authority has also not pointed out the need for custodial interrogation of the petitioner / accused in the report filed by them. As per the Bail Objection report, the petitioner / accused has no criminal antecedents. At this stage of the case, this Court is satisfied that no purpose will be accomplished by further detaining the petitioner / accused in the judicial custody. Anyhow, if the investigating authority has any sort of apprehension that the petitioner / accused may repeat similar offences, threaten or otherwise influence the witnesses, and may abscond, the same can be resolved by imposing strict conditions.

8. Hence, I am inclined to release the petitioner / accused on bail on the



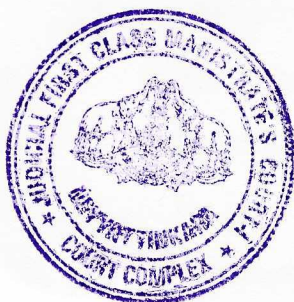


following strict conditions:

1. The petitioner / accused shall execute bond for Rs.50,000/- with 2 solvent sureties each for the like sum.
2. The petitioner / accused shall appear before the investigating officer on all Saturdays between 9.00 am and 4.00 pm for two months or until filing of the final report, whichever is earlier.
3. The petitioner / accused shall not intimidate or influence witnesses or shall not tamper with evidence.
4. The petitioner / accused shall not commit any similar offence while on bail.
5. The petitioner / accused shall appear before the Court as and when required.
6. On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, bail will be cancelled.
