The Plaintiff has filed this application for seeking production of certain documents.

02. The Defendant, through their learned counsel, has opposed the application by filing a say on application itself. It is contended that the documents sought to be produced were not presented at the relevant stage as required under Order-VII, Rule-14 of The Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 and for this reason, he prayed that, the application be rejected with costs.

04. Considering the nature of suit and the nature of documents sought to be filed, it can be seen that, the same appears to be relevant in respect of the present suit. Allowing the production would ultimately assist the Court in deciding the suit on merits. While Order-VII, Rule-14 of the CPC emphasizes timely production of documents, the Court has the discretion to allow production of documents at a later stage if deemed necessary for the ends of justice.
