Examination-in-chief recorded by Shri. V.D.Gupta Advocate for the Applicant :-

1. On 02/03/2026 I have examined Mr. Nazibullah Abdullah, 37 years for assessment of disability in connection with a vehicular accident on 11/12/2022 and he was treated at MGM Hospital from 11/12/2022 to 12/12/2022 and later at LTMG Hospital Sion from 13/12/2022 to 12/01/2023 as indoor patient. O.P.D. treatment thereafter. On perusal of Hospital papers noted following injuries :-

- 1) fracture right tibia mide shaft
- 2) blunt injury to right leg

2. Treatment given was CRIF with tibia interlocking nailing done on 17/12/2022 at LTMG Hospital. I examined clinically and radiologically and noted 5 disabilities as mentioned in the certificate. Now, the disability certificate of patient Nazibullah shown to me bears my signature and stamp also the photo and signature of the patient Nazibullah. Its contents are true and correct and according to the disability certificate, I have assessed the disability 64 % partial permanent. It is at **Exh.U-26**.

Further Examination in chief completed.

Matter is proceeded ex-parte against opponent No.1 hence, no cross examination on behalf of opponent No.1.

Cross examination by Adv. Jagruti Thakkar for Insurer :

3. It is true to say that, I have never treated the patient. Only I have issued disability certificate. Except copy of disability certificate, I have no other document to show residence of the

patient. I don't keep any record to show that the patient visited to my clinic. I have not taken fresh x-ray, MRI and Scan report. I have done screening. I have no report to show that I have done screening. I don't check the license of the person because of the injury he is not able to drive the vehicle. It is true to say that, because of the injury applicant is not able to drive the vehicle. It is true to say that, in the hospital papers and the discharge card nowhere it is written that patient required physiotherapy and any future treatment. I have no idea that if implant is removed in Govt. Hospital patient has to incur any expenses.

Question -Whether you have referred to percentage of disability mentioned for non schedule injury in WC Act?

Ans- I have no referred the WC Act as I don't understand WC Act.

4. It is not true to say that, difficulties mentioned in disability certificate is complaint of the patient and not the clinical and radiological examination. It is true to say that, I often issue disability certificate before this court and Motor Accident Court and depose before the Hon'ble Court. It is not true to say that, I have not examined the patient. It is not true to say that, patient has not sustained disability. It is not true to say that, whatever mentioned in the disability certificate is to help the applicant to get compensation. It is not true to say that, while issuing disability certificate photograph and signature of the applicant was not taken.
