The decree is for recovery of money. Till date, the decretal amount is unsatisfied. The amount pending for recovery is Rs. 23,671/-. On last date, JD has submitted application and sought time. Today JD has not taken any steps. None present for JD. According to the learned advocate of DH, police protection is required because JD is releasing dogs for restraining execution. This aspect is clarified by DH by filing affidavit. In order to satisfy the decree I proceed to pass the following order.

2.	Issue recovery warrant.
3.	Police protection is also allowed.
4.	The concerned police station to provide escort of one male and one female police officer at the time of execution of decree by recovery warrant for protection.
5.	Decree holder is directed to submit or deposit the fees of police protection at the office of SP, Sangli or as per rules.
