Defendant filed the present application for setting aside the deemed order of “No written statement” and “no say” to interim application at Exh.5 as he could not file the written statement and say within time. He prayed to allow the application by condoning the delay.

(2). Plaintiff resisted the application by filing his say on the backside of the application itself. He prayed for rejection of application, if allowed, then it should be with heavy cost.

(3). Perused application, say and record and proceeding. The contents mentioned by the defendant in the application does not appear to be incorrect or malafide one. Therefore, a chance should be given to contest the matter on merits. The matter is pertaining to the recovery of amount. Therefore, it would be better to have the written statement of defendant on record for effective adjudication of the matter. In view of this the following order is passed.

ORDER

- (1). The application below Exh.17 is hereby allowed. No order as to costs.
- (2). The delay to file the written statement and say to interim application is hereby condoned.
