



Order Below Exh.24 in RCC No.280/2025
(State / Mohammad Ramjan Samsher Khan & Anr)

1. This is an application for relaxation of conditions imposed by a bail order. Perused application. Perused say of Ld. APP.
2. Heard the Ld. Advocate of accused and Ld. APP.
3. According to accused, it is not possible for him to furnish a solvent surety for Rs.50,000/-. So also it was not possible for him to communicate with his near relatives from the jail. Therefore, the condition No.2 in the order below Exh.22 be relaxed. He is ready to furnish the addresses of his son and his brother-in-law. Ld. APP resisted the application with submission that accused is resident of Hyderabad and therefore the strict compliance of the conditions imposed by an order below Exh.22 is necessary.
4. Upon perusal of record, it appears that accused is having age of 54 years and is a resident of Hyderabad. The bail has been granted on 25.09.2025 vide an order below Exh.22. Accused is in judicial custody since 14.02.2025. In such case, in order to facilitate the personal liberty, the conditions can be relaxed. However, the amount looking to be involved in the case is of Rs.46,93,000/- and hence, it is a huge one. In such case, accused cannot be released by relaxing the condition of furnishing the surety. However, as mentioned above, to facilitate the personal liberty of accused, the condition as to local solvent surety can be relaxed and accused may be enlarged on bail upon furnishing a local

surety. In addition, accused has prayed for relaxation of condition directing to furnish residential addresses of three blood relatives. However, looking at the fact that accused is not a local resident and the amount involved is a huge one, therefore, the said condition cannot be relaxed. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) Application is partly allowed in terms of the condition No.2 of the bail order below Exh.22 dated 25.09.2025.
- 2) Instead of 'local solvent surety', accused to furnish 'local surety' for Rs.50,000/-.
- 3) Other conditions laid down in the order below Exh.22 be complied.
