This is an application for providing exhibits to document enlisted at Exh. 20/1 to 13, 20/22, 20/27, 20/28, 20/31, 20/37 and 20/38. Two documents enlisted at Exh. 35/1, 35/6 and 35/7 to Exh. 89/1, Exh. 92/1 and 92/2. This application is resisted by respondents. Heard both sides.
