1. The **applicant** has filed the present application under Section 497 BNSS, for release on superdari, the mobile bearing **IMEI No. 867735066382113**.
2. Reply of IO received, wherein it is stated that the IO has no objection if the mobile is released, as it is no more required for investigation.
3. I have gone through the documents on record.
4. Certain guidelines have been laid down in *Sundarbhai Ambalal vs. State of Gujrat (2002) 10 SCC 283* and *Manjit Singh vs. State (2014) 214 DLT 646* for dealing with applications of such nature. Considering the facts and circumstances, nature of offence and law laid down, the mobile phone mentioned above be released to the applicant by IO on furnishing security bond as per the market value of the article and after preparation of *panchnama* and taking photographs of mobile (from all angles), counter signed by complainant and the person who is being given the custody. IMEI number and copy of ownership proof be verified and retained. Record shall be filed along-with final report. Seized documents, if any, be also released.
5. The Owner shall produce the mobile before this court as and when directed by this court and shall not transfer ownership of the mobile to anyone, nor possession of the same will be parted with, until the disposal of this case. Further, the owner shall not change the colour or appearance of the mobile.
