**JUDGMENT**  
**(Delivered on 09/05/2026)**

1. Accused is appeared before me and submitted that he want to plead his guilt.
2. I have explained him the consequences of pleading guilty and asked him whether he pleaded guilty under any fear or pressure. It appears to me that the accused is pleading his guilt voluntarily. Accordingly, I have framed Particular against him for the offence punishable under Section 84 of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act and read over the contents thereof in vernacular to which they pleaded guilty.
3. Before passing the final sentence, I heard the accused only point of sentence. They submitted that he is only earning member of his family and he is very poor. Hence, considering the submissions, it would be just and proper to take lenient view while awarding the sentence. Hence, I am of the considered view that following sentence would meet the ends of justice. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following order:

**ORDER**

The accused is convicted for the offence punishable under **Section 84 of the Maharashtra Prohibition Act** vide Section 275 of BNSS and is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/- and in default of payment of fine to suffer simple imprisonment for 3 (Three) days.
