ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Perused the application and reports as to the service of notices. From the record it appears that original respondent No.2, respondent No.3, respondent No.4, respondent No.5 are shown dead and their legal heirs are brought on record. Considering the age of daughters of the deceased respondents, they appear to be married, as names shown in the title clause are not maternal names, however all the addresses given are that of their real brother. As stated above it can not be said that the addresses of those legal heirs i.e. daughters of deceased respondents are correct. In consequence no adverse order can be passed against them. The applicant to make statement as to whether the daughters of deceased respondents, who are dead, are married or not married and if they are married, what are their addresses after marriage. If applicant fails to make statement as directed, the court will pass suitable adverse order against applicant.
