ORDER BELOW EXH 29 :

The applicant/accused has filed this application for bail. It appears from the record that, in the present case applicant was on bail. He was not attending in proceeding and remained absent. Hence, his bail bonds were cancelled and he was arrested.

2. Without going to the merit of the case, prima-facie it shows that, applicant/accused has surrendered himself in court. The prosecution by giving say submitted that appropriate order may be passed.

3. Perused the record and proceeding. The applicant was initially on bail. Hence, without touching to the merit of the case, I am of the opinion that applicant/accused shall enlarged on bail. In result I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] The applicant shall be released on bail on furnishing P.B. of ₹. 15,000/- [₹. Fifteen Thousand] with one solvent surety in the like amount, in aforesaid crime, on the following conditions;
 - i) Applicant shall not tamper the prosecution evidence in any manner and shall not threaten the informant and witnesses.

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ii) Applicant is directed to attend the court regularly.

iii) Applicant shall submit his authentic permanent residential address and of his three close relatives along with mobile phone number duly verified.
