JUDGMENT

The accused is suo motu appeared today. He has admitted the offence leveled against him by filing pursis along with self-attested photocopy of his identity. The accused voluntarily pleads guilty of the offence with which he is charged herein. Upon inquiry, I have found that the guilt so confessed by the accused is without any compulsion, force or inducement. I have also informed the accused that in case he plead guilty of the offence, he might be subjected to the punishment as prescribed by law and therefore, he should not be under an impression that only because of his such confession, the Court would think of awarding him lesser or lenient punishment. Even then the accused asserts that he is voluntarily pleading guilty in the matter. The accused

has prayed for the leniency. Considering the nature of the offence and the age of the accused along with submissions of the accused, it is necessary to pass lenient sentence. In the result, I pass the following order :

ORDER

1)	The accused Anil Channu Chavan is hereby convicted for the offence punishable under Section 84 of the Bombay Prohibition Act to pay fine of <u>Rs.300/- (Rupees Three Hundred only)</u> in default to suffer simple imprisonment for seven (07) days.
2)	Copy of order be given to the accused free of costs.
