**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 7.**

This is an application filed by the complainant for amendment in the complaint.

2. The complainant has submitted that, the present complaint is filed under section 138 of the N.I.Act against the accused. The complainant wants to amend pleading in para no.2 and wants to insert new pleading therein. Further complainant wants to amend pleading in para no.3 and 4. The complainant has further submitted that the amendment sought is technical in nature and it does not alter the nature of the complaint. Therefore, for the proper adjudication of the matter, the complainant has requested that the application be allowed.

3. Perused the application, and after reviewing the documents on record, and hearing the learned advocate for complainant, it is observed that, the present case is at initial stage i.e. pending for awaiting summons of accused. The amendment sought is necessary for the proper adjudication of the matter and to avoid multiplicity of proceedings. It is noted that the proposed amendment will not alter or change the

nature of the complaint. Furthermore, no prejudice will be caused to the accused if the application is allowed. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

**ORDER**

- i) The application is allowed.
- ii) The complainant is directed to carry out proposed amendment and to file on record a copy of the amended complaint within 14 days without fail.
