The complainant *vide pursis* (Exh.18) has abandoned the proceeding stating that he has received the amount of cheque out of Court. The contents of *pursis* (Exh.18) are verified. - (1) The complaint stands withdrawn *vide* S.257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- (2) Accused Rupali Balkrishna Kumbhar is discharged for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 *vide* section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- (3) Issue Court Fee Refund Certificate, if any, as per rules.
